All K-12 Teachers Job Listings Get Greater Tips & Advice Ontario recently released the annual Sunshine List a public record listing the names of public sector employees earning more than \$100,000 annually (more than double Canada's average national salary of \$47,200). Growing in size by more than 11% from last year's \$100,000 club, the list includes some surprising members, including parking attendants and teachers who make more than the average lawyer. Here are five surprising careers with above-average earning potential that don't involve days spent sitting behind a desk. Although teachers didn't all hit the \$100,000 mark, teachers in Ontario have an average salary of \$83,500, which puts them on par with the average lawyer in Ontario, according to Macleans Magazine, which counted 88 teachers in Hamilton alone, making more than \$100,000. Police Officers Over 3,000 Toronto Police Officers earn more than \$100,000 a year, according to Sunshine List. Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police can also earn up to \$80,000 after just three years of service, with the ability to jump above the \$100,000 mark with degrees, such as the staff sergeant and inspector. If you want to work in a mobile office, this is a career choice with great benefits and above-average earning potential. Although firefighters Although the basic salary for a firefighter in Canada is not likely to reach \$100,000 (depending on the Canada Service the average income of a firefighter in Canada is \$65,000), unusual working hours contribute to the extra earnings that can bump into the \$100,000 club. For example, 54 firefighters in the city of Kitchener, Ontario, make more than \$100,000. Service Canada says job prospects are good for this career, which provides excellent benefits, varied working hours and potentially good pay for people who want to work in a physically demanding career. Nurses followed by teachers, the most common jobs on the Sunshine List are nurses, with nearly 2,000 making more than \$100,000 a year in Ontario. According to the Canadian Nurses Association, the salary of RNs ranges from \$40,000 to \$80,000 (with room for overtime), making this a well-paid career option for people who like to think on their feet. If paramedic thrives in a stressful and fast-paced work environment, becoming a paramedic is a well-paid career option that keeps you on your toes. Alberta Health Services says paramedics win dollars to \$42.90 per hour (about \$65,000 to \$85,000 per year).
